





I finished my PhD in summer of 2013 and subsequently I started as a post doc researcher at the same lab on an industry project developing feed additives for pigs and poultry (mainly broilers). From 2015 until March 2018, I worked 80% at Eastman Chemical Company developing feed additives, preservatives and drinking water additives for livestock (pigs, poultry, and dairy) and remained 20% post doc at Ghent University. Since April 1st I shifted from industry to Inagro, a local research institute doing practical research and giving advise to local farmers. Here I lead a project on the use of different sources of drinking water for pigs. Additionally, I organize farmers meetings to share knowledge with and between pig farmers and teach on regular basis for farmers, vets and students in practical topics related to pig nutrition.
